

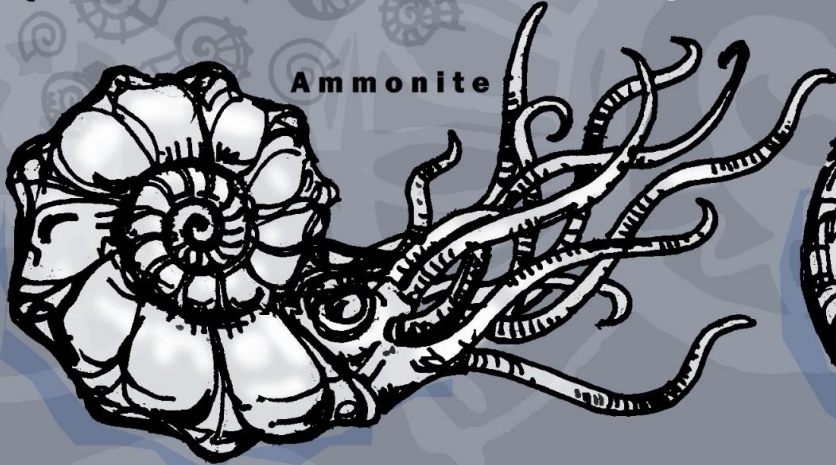
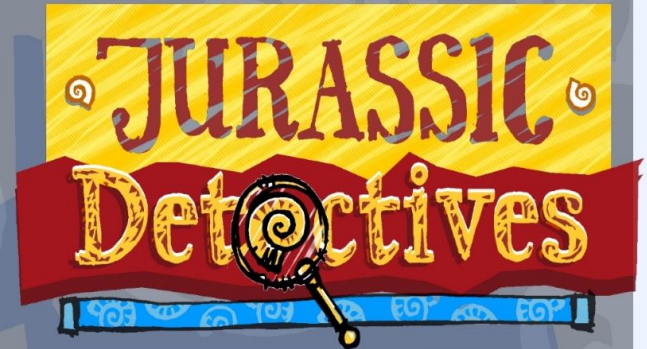


# Astonishing Ammonites

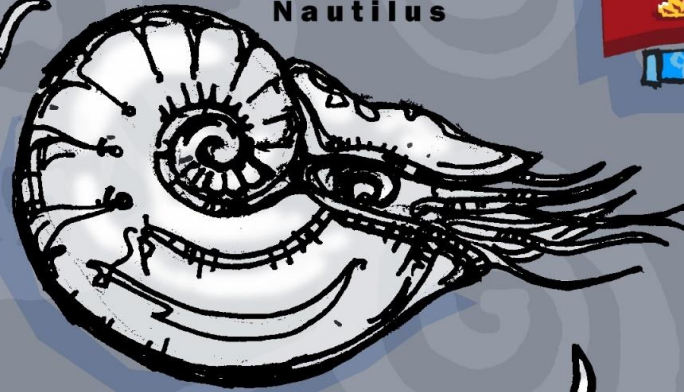
Ammonites were marine dwelling creatures similar to the modern day nautilus.

... and what differences?

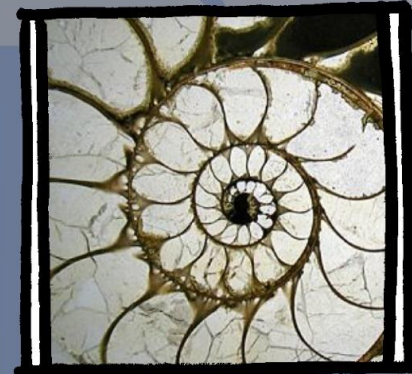


Ammonite
